I obtained my MSc (2006) and PhD (2011) degrees from the University of Pretoria, focusing on the systematics and taxonomy of Anostostomatidae crickets (MSc) and the dynamics of *Bartonella* infections in rodents from South Africa (PHd). My research interests include systematics, zoonotic and infectious diseases, veterinary microbiology, epidemiology and mathematical modeling as well as conservation genetics. To this end I rely on strongly on molecular phylogenics and systematics techniques, and am also expanding to include real-time technology. Current projects include the development of molecular diagnostics tests for veterinary pathogens, subspecies identification of wildlife species of conservation concern, molecular identification of rodent species and their associated an potentially zoonotic pathogens.
